

## **Coolabunia Sale Report Tuesday 21<sup>st</sup> February 2017**

The Coolabunia combined agents sold 289 head at the fortnightly prime and store sale on Tuesday 21/2/17. The market was slightly easier for all descriptions but the quality young cattle were keenly sort after. This is due to the seasonal conditions that have been exceptionally hot and dry. If we were to get a good break in the weather I feel the market would improve but we are getting closer to winter and some producers are reducing their numbers in case winter is as tough as summer. 3 inches of rain would change everything.
