A lighter yarding sold to a slightly dearer market for quality feeder cattle and export with store cattle slightly easier for lesser quality cattle. If the rain was to start falling I feel the market would improve as there are not a lot of cattle around but with the prolonged dry spell restockers are selective in their purchases.
